

The Routes of the Frankopans – full day excursion November 25th / November 26th

Trsat Castle (Gradina Trsat in Croatia) has been standing on Trsat to guard the city since the 13th century. The castle was built on the ruins of ancient Illyrian and Roman castles and originally owned by the most eminent noble family of the region at that time - the Frankopan family came from neighboring Krk Island. The Francopan Castel in Kraljevica was built in the mid 17th century as a late renaissance lavishly decorated residential palace with four corner towers. After the devastation it was re flourished in late 19th century.

Drivenik Castle was first mentioned in 13th century and since then it was seat of the district administration. In the 16th century the castle was expanded in size and style of Renaissance fortresses it received rount towers on tis corners. Be sure to visit Fortress in Bribir and also the House Klović with a permanent replica of this Renaissance miniature artist Juraj Julij Klović.

After visit to these castles we will rest in nearby restaurant serving local food and drinks.

On the way back we will visit Kvadrac castle – the only remnant of castle that the Frankopans erected in the 13th century. In “the great palace” the Law Codex of Vinodol was written in 1288, the most important text of mediaeval life in the Frankopan possession of Vinodol. It is written in the Croatian language in the Glagolitic script, and adopted on the square in front of the castle that same year.
